## Policy for the future:

APP group conserves wildlife by mapping populations of three key animal species – Sumatran tiger, Sumatran elephant, and Bornean orangutan – in supplier concession areas with protecting over 600,000 ha of natural forest in Indonesia.

In addition, APP group addresses the land-scape level forest conservation through Belantara foundation by protecting/restoring forest and supporting local community even surrounding the concession.
